Acetoacet-2,5-dimethoxy-4-chloroanilide (CAS No. 4433-79-8) (provided for in subheading 2924.29.76).

Acetoacet-2,5-dimethoxy-4-chloroanilide is a synthetic organic chemical that is used as a coupling component for azoic dyeing. It is also known as Naphthol AS-IRG. The product is imported from India, China, Germany, and Switzerland.

3 **SECTION 1. ACETOACETYL-2,5-DIMETHOXY-4-**
4 **CHLOROANILIDE.**

5 (a) IN GENERAL.—Subchapter II of chapter 99 of
6 the Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States is
7 amended by inserting in numerical sequence the following
8 new heading:
